In January 2003 the IEEE approved the **802.16a** standard, which covers frequency bands between 2 GHz and 11 GHz. This standard is an extension of the IEEE 802.16 standard for 10 - 66 GHz published in April 2002. These sub 11 GHz frequency ranges enable non line-of-sight performance, making the IEEE 802.16a standard the appropriate technology for last-mile applications. WiMAX (**Worldwide Interoperability for Microwave Access**) is a specific implementation of IEEE 802.16 on these ranges with equipment interoperability certification.

The advancement of the above standard and technology plus the strong demand of the market has given rise to a potential market of Broadband Wireless Access (BWA) in Hong Kong. OFTA has also sought views on the Licensing Framework for Deployment of BWA on Dec 2004. HKPC and WTIA are going to organize **the 1st WiMAX Forum 2005** in Hong Kong on 17 Feb 2005. During this forum, we will invite telecom regulators and industry experts to give talks and discussions focusing on this emerging broadband wireless standard and technology, its applications, business cases and the licensing framework to be adopted in Hong Kong.
